PREP PROCESS

We're confident in the quality of our work and have years of experience where we've perfected our process. All of our work comes with a two year warranty and the option of purchasing an additional three year warranty.

The "no prep needed" marketing pitch from major paint vendors couldn't be less true, especially for something designed for every day use like kitchen cabinets. Proper prep ensures your cabinets won't peel or experience other paint failure. It's the bread for your butter.



FIRST STEP: UNINSTALL

The first step of our prep process is to remove/label all the doors and drawer fronts. Hardware, bumper pads, and other items such as stickers or tape are then removed

SECOND STEP: CLEAN

Even the tidiest of home owners would be surprised at how much build up actually occurs on cabinets. Think of how much you cook or of all the hands that come into contact with your cabinets (both big and small). These surfaces need to be cleaned so those oils aren't pushed into the wood while sanding. We use a specific degreaser, and in some cases specialty contour scrapers, to remove these layers before moving on to sanding.

THIRD STEP: SAND

Proper sanding is crucial to the prep process. It's important to scuff up the surface in order for paint to stick. Especially for older cabinets and grains like oak, sanding exfoliates the surface giving you a fresh, ready to work with finish. We use a variety of grits as well as a state of the art blasting system for the nooks and crannies. We sand between coats, from the first coat of primer to the second to last coat of paint, ensuring a smooth, even finish

FOURTH STEP: PRIME

Primer is also an important factor to a long lasting paint job. It acts as an adhesiv, making sure the product used isn't soaking into the wood thereby needing multiple coats of paint. The first coat of primer we use has a specialty stain blocking formula. This is to ensure that natural wood knots don't bleed through to the painted surface. The second kind of primer used is specific for strong adhesion. While most primers advertise both of these properties there is no such thing as an "all in one" primer. We use a sprayer to apply and a back rolling technique to quarantee a quality application

FIFTH STEP: PAINT

The paint base and product used are essential for painting cabinets. We use a highly rated, water based enamel paint that comes with a manufacturer guarentee. It dries with a diamond finish and is super durable. Our MagnumX5 spray system ensures a smooth, factory finish
